Hello Nottingham Mommies and Daddies:

Fall is here which means we say goodbye to the humidity! We have had a wonderful September start and the children are settling in nicely and are beginning to feel comfortable in their surroundings! Thank you for the quick goodbyes at the door/gate. You have helped to make this transition smooth and less traumatic for your child. Thank you to a few of our parents who have been asked to stay to give their child the longer transitional period that they need to adjust to their program. Patience and time is the key!

Now we look forward to October. The children are already so excited about their costumes and Halloween festivities. As we enter this holiday season here are a few reminders:

Please no scary masks!!

The children can come dressed in their costumes.

Do not bring candy into the school, Nottingham will provide a special Halloween snack.

Additional October reminders:

Please check your Monthly Nottingham Calendar for events, this is a valuable communication tool between the teachers and parents. Also please make sure you have a change of clothes in your child's back pack and a pair of slip-on Velcro shoes or rubber boots for your child to use during outdoor play. Proving a shoe that is easy to put on will help the teachers greatly. Lastly, please make sure all clothes and shoes are properly labeled with your child's name.

October's Phonics:

Letter's **B** and **C** will be explored through puppetry, jolly phonics, stories, games, and hands-on activities. Students will also enjoy spiders, snakes and pumpkins in their sensory play.

Math:

Children will be counting pumpkins, bats, and so much more! Children will experiment with measurement through water play and using the Apple Pie Wooden Set children will explore various measurement such as: $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, and one whole pie.

Science:

Children will hypothesize how long it take for ice to melt. Also "What is happening to our goop? Eeek! It's turning Black!"
